Custodial Technician (Vernon): Duties and Responsibilities:

The Custodial Technician is responsible to the Supervisor of Custodians. This is a security-sensitive position and is subject to a criminal history record. (Texas Government Code 411.094 & Texas Education Code 51.215)

Specific duties include:

- 1. To perform activities as necessary to maintain buildings in a clean, orderly, and comfortable condition.
- 2. To assume primary responsibility for maintaining cleanliness of assigned areas.
- 3. To maintain and utilize all conventional custodial equipment and tools necessary to performing custodial tasks.
- 4. To be responsible for informing the Supervisor of Custodians of any supplies or equipment needs necessary to perform the assigned duties.
- 5. To inform the Supervisor of Custodians of any special physical needs of the areas assigned.
- 6. To notify the proper authorities of security violations.
- 7. To maintain the cleanliness of all entrance and exits to buildings.
- 8. To assist in removing snow from walkways, entrances, and exits during winter months.
- 9. To assist in the general maintenance and operation of all areas of the physical plant.
- 10. To be able to lift a minimum of 30 pounds.
- 11. To be able to operate electrical machines used in routine custodial duties such as vacuum cleaners, strippers, and buffers.
- 12. To assume special responsibilities on assignment by the Supervisor of Custodians and/or the Director of Physical Plant.
