

Assistant Rodeo Coach: Duties and Responsibilities:

The Assistant Rodeo Coach reports to the Rodeo Coach, Assistant Athletic Director, Athletic Director, and the President. **This is a security-sensitive position and is subject to a criminal history record. (Texas Government Code 411.094 & Texas Education Code 51.215)** Specific duties include:

1. To assist all College farming operations and activities at the Pease River Farm, including meeting the approved farming calendar and reporting annual recommendations for improvement to the Rodeo Coach, Athletic Director, and President
2. To assist the Rodeo Coach in the leadership and direction of the rodeo program as well as ensure that all rodeo facilities and livestock are properly maintained and cared for.
3. To foster strong, responsible character and behavior development in the students with whom he/she works.
4. To assist in the supervision of rodeo practices.
5. To maintain rodeo team area and care for livestock while head coach and team are on road trips, and as assigned by the head coach.
6. To assist in recruiting students of high moral character, academic achievement, demonstrated leadership skills and rodeo ability.
7. To assist in preparing for and implementing the College's annual N.I.R.A. rodeo.
8. To actively foster within the college, community, region and state, a positive image for the rodeo program.
9. To assume special responsibilities on assignment by the Rodeo Coach, Assistant Athletic Director, Athletic Director and/or the President.
